Rules of the "Mater Ecclesiae" competition

 The organiser of the competition and the administrator of the participants' personal data is Institute of the Immaculate Mother of the Church

- 2. The aim of the competition is to familiarise the participants with the Mariology of the Servant of God Fr. Francis Blachnicki and to popularise his teaching.
- 3. Participation in the competition is voluntary and free of charge.
- 4. The competition is organized in two categories, two subcategories in each:
 4.1 Art competition primary school pupils or families.
 4.2 Multimedia competition secondary school pupils or adult groups.
- Rules for participation in the art competition (1st competition category):
 5.1 Primary school pupils (individually) or willing families (jointly) make an artwork on the theme "Mater Ecclesiae" in A4 format. The work must be a flat piece, capable of being safely transported by post. Any technique may be used EXCLUDING computer technology (graphics, prints, etc.).

5.2 The work and the printed, completed and signed application form (attached to these Rules and Regulations) must be sent at one's own expense in a secure envelope by 31.03.2023 to the address of the INMK (see point 1 of the Rules) with the note "competition".

- 5.3 The evaluation is subject to:
- 5.3.1 The relevance, clarity and creativity in the presentation of the topic,
- 5.3.2. Aesthetics of the work,
- 5.3.3. Accuracy and labour intensity of the execution technique.
- 6. Rules for participation in the multimedia competition (2nd category of the competition):

6.1 Groups of secondary school pupils or adult groups prepare a multimedia project to the theme "Mater Ecclesiae", e.g. a film, multimedia presentation, radio play, podcast, theatrical performance, etc. of up to 10 minutes in length (or of such volume that the entire content can be read in up to 10 minutes). 6.2 The group can consist of 2-4 people.

6.3 The project file or a link to download the project and a scan of the completed and signed application form should be sent by 31.03.2023 to the following address: inmk@oaza.pl (the form is attached to these rules).

6.4 The evaluation is subject to:

6.4.1 The relevance, clarity and creativity in the presentation of the topic,

6.4.2. Substantive level and aspect of promoting the teaching of the Servant of God Fr. Francis Blachnicki,

6.4.3. Aesthetics, ingenuity and technique of the project.

- 7. The organisers will select candidates for the1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in both categories. They will be awarded with prizes, including: vouchers for a weekend stay at the INMK house in Zakopane or at the Father Franciszek Blachnicki hermitage in Dursztyn. Settlement of the competition and the awarding of prizes will take place during the celebrations of the 50th anniversary of the Light-Life Movement on 11.06.2023 in Krościenko nad Dunajcem.
- 8. Entry to the Competition requires consent to the processing of personal data for the purposes of running the Competition, selecting the winners and awardees, awarding prizes and for the purposes of promotion and information about the Competition, in accordance with the regulations in force. Failure to give such consent means that participation in the Competition is cancelled.
